

Dress Rehearsal @ Mount Baker Theatre Saturday, December 10th

Dress rehearsal is a very important time, not only for dancers, but also for the choreographers and stage/lighting crew at M.B.T. We have a very small amount of time to accomplish a great deal. Please be sensitive, and quiet, while watching dress rehearsal, as this is a privilege.

Parents may take pictures and videotape during their child's time slot. There will be no pictures or videotaping allowed during the actual show so pre-order your copy of a professional DVD at the show.

For your convenience, we have broken down the dress rehearsal into time slots. These time slots are not guaranteed, but a guide for you to know an approximate time commitment. We do our very best to stick to these time slots. **Please arrive early, in costume with hair & make-up done,** stretched out, and ready to rehearse.

Dancers need to attend this dress rehearsal in order to perform. Plan on being at the MBT at least 15-20 minutes before your timeslot or the finale (whichever is first for you). We will make every effort to stay on schedule, but cannot guarantee that we will be done on time.
