

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR DRESS REHEARSAL @ MBT

Dress rehearsal is a very important time, not only for dancers, but also for the choreographers, stage, and lighting crew at MBT. We have a very small amount of time to accomplish a great deal. Please be mindful and quiet while watching dress rehearsal, as it is a privilege.

Parents may take pictures and video during their dancer's time slot. There will be no pictures or video allowed during the live performances.

<u>Dancers MUST attend this dress rehearsal to perform.</u> Plan on being at the MBT at least 15-20 minutes before your time slot. We will make every effort to stay on schedule but cannot guarantee that we will be done on time.

For your convenience, we have broken down the dress rehearsal into time slots. These time slots are not guaranteed, but a guide for you to know an approximate time commitment. We do our very best to stick to these time slots.

Please arrive early, in costume with hair & make-up done, warmed-up, and ready to rehearse. Rehearsal schedules are posted at both our Bellingham and Lynden studios and are also available on our website.

# INSTRUCTIONS FOR SHOW DAYS: Friday, June 16 - Monday, June 19

#### Arrival:

- All performers enter through the Commercial Street entrance.
- Dancers will then find their designated table/area in the Walton room and connect with the volunteer that is assigned for their group.
- 3. Dancers must already have their costumes on, makeup and hair done, and be ready to perform when they enter the Walton Theatre. Dancers should bring minimal items with them and <u>leave all valuable items at home</u>. Please label all items brought into the Walton Theatre and contain them in a bag or backpack.

Dancers will not be allowed to leave the Walton Theatre Room once they are there. The show will be playing live in this room so kids can watch the performance.

#### Intermission:

All Young Dancers\* who performed in the first half will be PICKED UP ON STAGE at the beginning of intermission. All Young Dancers\* performing in the second half of the show will need to be brought to the Commercial Street entrance at the beginning of intermission. Send only one parent/guardian to drop off your dancer by getting a re-entry stamp at the main entrance, walking your dancer down the sidewalk to the Commercial Street door, and dropping them off with the DFJ staff member at the Commercial Street door.

#### Finale:

All dancers are able to join in the Finale which is the very last dance. Young Dancers\* who would like to be in the Finale will need to be brought to the auditorium tunnel a few dances before the end of the show. There will be an announcement made in the theatre when it is time to go!

\* Young Dancers are those in Tiny Twirlers, Creative Movement, Hippity Hop, and all Pre-Classes)

#### Pick Up:

When the show ends, dancers will be picked up in one of two places:

- ON STAGE- All Young Dancers\*. Send ONLY ONE parent/guardian to the edge of the stage and a DFJ staff member will bring your child to you.
- AUDITORIUM TUNNEL All other dancers. Parents/guardians will stay in the auditorium. Dancers will be dismissed from the auditorium tunnel by DFJ staff, one class at a time. When your dancer's class is announced, send ONLY ONE parent/guardian to the tunnel door to meet your dancer and check them out.

#### Important:

Students will not be allowed to leave without a parent/guardian. This is for safety. The MBT Staff ask that we keep the foyer area clear when leaving the theatre.

#### Stage Makeup:

Makeup is necessary when dancing under stage lighting. The intensity of the lights washes out facial features making the face appear blurry or far away. When seen up close the makeup may seem overdone, but it will look quite natural from the audience. The guide here will help you apply makeup to your dancer. Please speak to your instructor if you have questions.



Important! If you have questions during the rehearsal or show days, please message us through Facebook or email only. Staff will not be available in the studio or by phone between June 15 -19.

### Pre-order Flowers for Your Dancer:

Save \$\$ by pre-ordering flowers for your dancer! Pre-ordered roses will be ready for you at MBT. Some flowers will be available for purchase at the theatre as well. All proceeds go toward costumes for our Jubilee Dance Company. Flowers can be purchased at the DFJ office using your card on file, cash or a check.

# REMINDERS

#### TICKETS AND VOUCHERS:

Vouchers are not tickets and must be exchanged for a ticket at the MBT box office. Tickets are only available for purchase through the Mount Baker Theatre. Ticket costs: \$15 for balcony and \$18 for main level seating.

MBT POLICY: Children under 2 who are sitting in your lap are given a comp ticket by Mt. Baker Theatre. These tickets are not provided in advance and must be picked up when you arrive at MBT for the show.
